- Collaborate with the Pastor/Head of Staff and Christian Education Committee on promoting and developing parent and other adult involvement with children and youth.
- Acquire and adapt curriculum materials to address the specific needs of the congregation.
- Recruit, train, and support teachers.
- Encourage, promote, and participate in spiritual development/renewal opportunities such as youth retreats, conferences, and mission trips.
- Identify and develop opportunities for the participation of children and youth in worship in coordination with the chair of the Worship Committee.
- Serve as ex-officio member of Session and Moderator of Session when invited by the Pastor/Head of Staff.

Compensation and Timing:

Compensation will follow the Presbytery compensation guidelines and will be based on qualifications and experience. Position begins on or before July 1, 2019.
