Sunday, March 31, is going to be a very special “Morning of Music and Mystery” at Fairfax Presbyterian Church. The day will begin with a single service of worship at 9:30 a.m., in place of the regular 8:45 and 11:15 services, and all are invited to attend.

*First, a Morning of Music:* At 9:30 a.m. the Sanctuary Choir will present the Brahms’ Requiem as a sermon in music in the Sanctuary. The service will begin at 9:30 a.m. and end at 11:00 a.m., because of the length of the Requiem. Included in this musical sermon is the powerful piece “Behold, I tell you a mystery,” from 1 Corinthians 15:51-52.

*Then, a Morning of Mystery:* Since there will be no second service of worship, all are invited to gather in the Fellowship Hall at 11:15 a.m. for a talk on pastor Henry Brinton’s mystery novel *City of Peace*. FPC’s “Men y Mujeres on a Mission” will sell copies of the novel for \$19.00 as a fundraiser for their mission work in Honduras. Henry Brinton will give a short talk, Yena Hwang will offer a response, and then Henry will sign books for those who are interested.

Together, the single service of worship and the book talk will constitute a “Morning of Music and Mystery.”
