

Saving Us: A Climate Scientist's Case for Hope & Healing

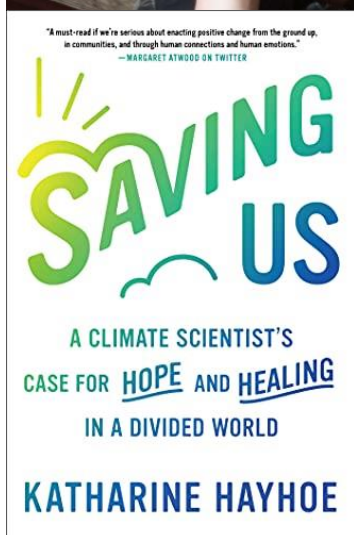
