- Oversee the planning and execution of spiritual formation opportunities through education and programming for pre-K through sixth grade.
- Direct/lead children's programming, such as Doorways to Worship, preteen club, VBS, Sacraments classes, summer camp, and pre-teen summer mission/service week.
- Provide leadership, organization, training, support, encouragement, accountability and appreciation to Children's Ministry volunteers.

Education and Experience:

- At least 4 years of relevant experience.
- Extensive experience teaching and/or public speaking.
- Possess working knowledge of the stages of child and faith development.

Personal Characteristics:
