Refugee Ministries Network



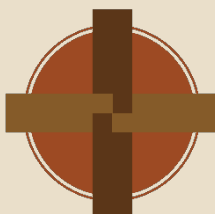
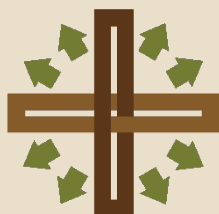
In fact, when you connect into the *Work of the Presbytery - Committees* link from the NCP website, you can find a point of contact and some updated information. Recently, **Earth Care Network** has shared an update from a grant with Rockville United Church. With a Power to Change Grant they have been able to replace old windows throughout their building with new Energy Star windows and refinish the exterior window frames.

Here is the expansive impact opportunity for you and your congregation: Congregations discern the focus of the missional impact! This is not prescribed by the Presbytery. Mission networks consist of 7 or more local congregations partnering together for a common cause. They are self-identified and self-directed groups. Each network will have a liaison who will report the work of the specific network back to respective Committees of the Presbytery. Mission networks are created when the participating partner churches present their common cause to the respective Committee (CDC or MCC) and receive approval to be a mission network.

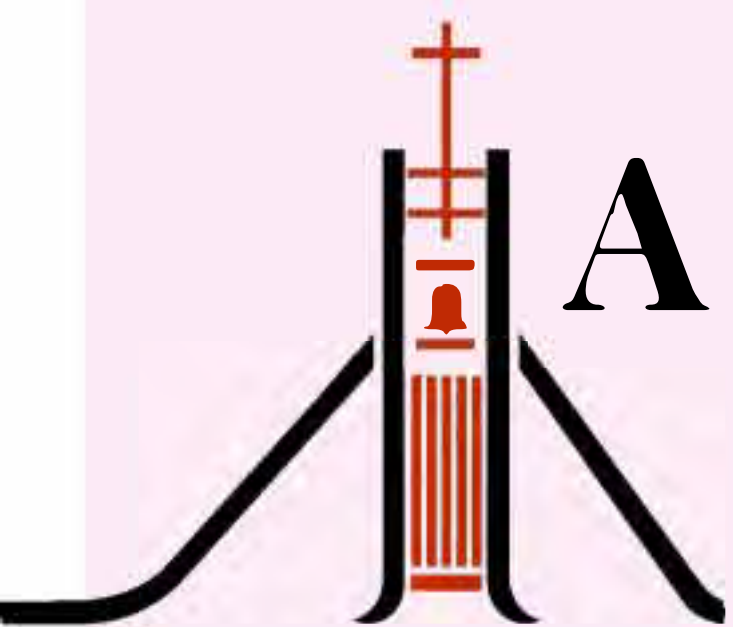

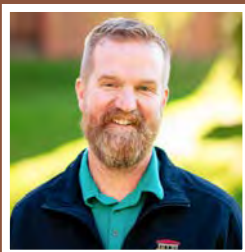

The workshops teach individuals about the causes of social injustice, how to be effective allies for marginalized communities, and how to actively influence and educate others. Our time together on Zoom will involve breakouts for practice together in pairs and small groups intermittently throughout our time of learning, so come ready to "try on" the Ally Training strategies of Service Never Sleeps.
