Dear NCP Churches and Pastors -

Fall blessings to you!

The month of September, the start of school and Sunday School Kick-Offs make our thoughts turn to...next year's church budget. As you plan for next year, a few things from the Committee on Ministry.

COLA Increases

COM, with the input of the presbytery staff, has struggled with how to account for inflation, without shocking church budgets. For 2023, a 6% increase would match the current inflation rate. COM is recommending a COLA increase of anywhere from 3% to 6% for pastors and church staff, as your church budget allows. If you choose 3%, you may add non-monetary benefits to cover some of the gap. For example, the church might offer two extra weeks off for 2023, and an additional two weeks for 2024.

The presbytery is following this model. This is meant to be a temporary benefit, in lieu of cash. Or the church might add money to the pastor's professional expense line, which does not add to the cost for benefits.

Increase in the cost of Board of Pensions benefits

If you are / your pastor is part of the Pastor's Participation plan from the Board of Pensions, those costs will increase to 39% of effective salary, as of January 1, 2023. (Up from 37%.)

Minimum Terms of Call

If you are searching for a new pastor, the minimum salary for pastors is also increasing, to keep up with inflation. The total salary, made up of cash plus housing, varies by zip code, as the cost of housing varies around the area. We can help you with this calculation. The base salary, before housing costs, will be \$39,473 plus housing for 2023.

Pastoral searches
