Find new ways to connect with our immediate community, including the unchurched, as well as local non-profit organizations and charities we support.

Moderate monthly Session meetings, Called Session meetings and Committee meetings as needed.

Moderate all Congregational Meetings as scheduled.

Serve as Head of staff. Provide oversight and support to all professional staff in consultation with Session's appointed Personnel Team.
