

## Director Let's Read! Literacy Tutoring Program - West Germantown Campus

## **Job Description**

Term of Service: September 1 – May 31 (program runs Oct 1 – May 23)

Hours: 20 hours/week

Primary

Responsibility: Oversee and direct the West Germantown campus of the Let's Read!

**Literacy Tutoring Program** 

Specific Duties to be carried out by Director or volunteers he/she oversees:

- 1. Implement a science-of-reading, phonics-based curriculum that will allow up to 25 second graders to grasp the fundamentals of reading in the context of biweekly, one-hour tutoring;
- 2. Purchase books, supplemental educational materials, and supplies for up to 25 one-on-one tutoring spots in a common community hall;
- 3. Publicize program with administration and staff of three local elementary schools as well as the general community;
- 4. Recruit, train, & coordinate adult and student volunteers to tutor and/or assist with tutoring on a weekly basis, creating systems for their care, supervision, and retention;
- 5. Register children for the program;
- 6. Interface and maintain positive relationship with parents, troubleshooting their concerns and supporting their role as parents;
- 7. Collaborate with tutors to track and determine reading/learning plan for each student;
- 8. Create warm, inviting and productive space for tutoring, awaiting parents, and tutors;

- 9. Oversee set up and breakdown of site for up to 25 tutor/student pairs, welcome table, waiting area, and MCAEL-sponsored ESL class;
- 10. Bi-weekly on-site management of entire program twice weekly between the hours of 4:00 and 7:00 p.m.
- 11. Maintain system of recording accurate attendance of all parties (students, adult volunteers, student volunteers, administrators);
- 12. Administer simple literacy assessment of each child at least twice through the year (October & May);
- 13. Submit mid-year reports of progress to parents re: their child and to hosting organization (GGC) about status of program;
- 14. Make recommendations to hosting organization re: scope, format, and other means of improving program for following year.
