# Transition to New Curriculum 8-4-4 to 6-3-3

- PLAN for future funding and stepping away
- WHY:
  - Decrease in sponsors over time
  - Transition to actual private school
  - Very few young orphans
  - Excellent improvement in overall QoL in region



# FTKI Plan:

---

- Slow decrease in KCCA funding through 2027
- Continue Capital Improvements w clear estimates and plans
- 8-4-4 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and HS students – fund through completion (2023-2027)
- Orphans starting junior high school under NEW Curriculum
  - Will attend public schools
  - FTKI will pay \$500 per year for living
- Final orphan completes education in 2029
- End of 2027, FTKI -> lump sum for few orphans in school through 2029
- Likely continued low level school support



# Financial Needs

- Pre-K to grade 6-8
  - 20 student/orphans
  - 300 (ish) community students
  - Was \$15k per Q – decr to \$13k('23), then \$10k('24), etc per Q
- High School orphans 2023/24
  - 33 students
  - \$32,000
- University and VoTech 2023 – education, med & Votech = only fields that don't require bribes
  - 48 students
  - \$43,000



# Other Opportunities

- Amua Africa Academy – on border of Tanzania(30 min walk)
- Run by young adult we know from KCCA and BrightStar(South B slum school)
- Serving orphans, vulnerable and youth living with disability
- 100 enrolled
- 10 staff that include teachers, cleaner and cook
